Rules: I.S.S.F. and Pistol Australia rules will be followed as closely as practicable. Local range rules (including competitors must not be in bays while range staff are down range), and local target configurations

Entries: Entries will be accepted in order of receipt up to range capacity by the closing date, Monday, 3rd February 2020. Competitors will be required to record their handgun licence and handgun serial numbers on the appropriate participation sheets at the Open. Please note: There are limited spaces for 50m pistol.

Entry Fees: \$15.00 per event + VAPA \$5.50 registration fee to accompany entry form. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees. Cheques etc to be made payable to Yarra Pistol Club Inc. Late Entries: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Secretary.

ID Cards: It is a condition of entry that all competitors produce V.A.P.A. ID card with a current financial sticker attached. Interstate competitors must provide proof of current Pistol Australia affiliation

Squadding: All competitors will be advised of their squadding via email. Squadding time is the commencement of the match. Preparation time is before this. Please note that for 10m Air Pistol and 50m Pistol events, competitors <u>must</u> be on the line 30 minutes prior to the commencement time of the match. Competitors may be squadded to assist on ranges.

Juniors shooting both senior and junior matches will shoot only one match (one entry fee will apply) and scores will count for both matches. Women may shoot both Centre Fire and Sport pistol if range capacity permits. Men may shoot Sport Pistol if range capacity permits.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each grade of each event. There will also be a Men's 5 Match Aggregate, a Women's 3 Match Aggregate (Air, 25m Pistol, Standard) and a Junior 2 Match Aggregate (Air, 25m Pistol). Presentations will be held at the end of each day, where possible. No trophies will be award to men for 25m pistol.

Catering: Light meals and snacks available both days. Hot and cold drinks and a fully licensed bar also available.

Camping: Unfortunately, it is a condition of our lease that camping is NOT permitted on the range.
